

'Hi Ho, Hi Ho, Off To School You Go!

The next chapter of your child's life is close to starting as you now learn their allocated school place.

In the coming months we will work closely with your child's planned school so please let us know should your child be off to another school other than Thorpe Greenways. This will allow us to contact the school to discuss whether they wish to visit us at Trinket Box as part of a transition programme. It will also allow us to liaise with them regarding transfer of your child's learning journey.

As you can appreciate we mainly feed our children into Thorpe Greenways so we work closely with the school regarding transition. We try to ensure that children have at least one friend within their class and in past experience there tends to be at least 10-12 Trinket Box children in each of the 5 classes.

We will advise the school should your child have any allergies or medical conditions but please ensure that you also make them fully aware during the enrolment process.

THUMBS UP FOR EXTRA FOREST SCHOOL

This is the first year that we have offered the facility of extra Forest School sessions with Kealey Kangaroo and take up has been really good.

This outdoor learning experience is a firm favourite amongst the school leaving children so please ensure your child isn't missing out! Kealey will build on your child's existing knowledge with other fabulous first hand experiences like growing fruit and veg and watching our very own frog spawn hatch! Pure awe and wonder experiences!

The cost of the extra sessions are £20 for 6 if these are accessed within your child's existing attendance pattern. If you prefer to pay for an additional session per week to incorporate forest school this will cost £60 for 6 sessions (the sessions will last approx. 2 hours each). 
QUOTE CORNER— THE POWER OF NATURE




FABULOUS FUNDRAISING!
